#### **General Information**

The Shire of Pingelly has introduced a free skip bin as a once a year service for bulk rubbish commencing on Monday 9 January 2017.

A skip bin can be booked by phoning the Shire on (08) 9887 1066 or coming in to the Shire Office at 17 Queen Street, Pingelly.

Shire Staff will arrange for a skip bin to be placed on your verge for a period of two weeks and will be emptied by the Shire Waste Contractor. Once the skip bin is emptied it will be relocated to the next resident requesting the service.

Please ensure that all waste for collection is placed in the skip bin and is kept below the top of the bin.

All waste not placed in the skip bin will not be collected after the skip bin has been emptied.





#### **Bulk Rubbish**

Only items that meet the following descriptions will be collected:

- household furniture
- stoves
- white goods excluding refrigerators unless certified de-gassed and doors are removed
- general junk
- E waste
- mattresses

Please place these items in the skip bin.

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

Items greater than 1.8m in length, width or height cannot be collected.

If items like cupboards can be dismantled it will stack easier into the skip bin and give you more space to fit more rubbish.

Refrigerators and air conditioners will not be collected unless accompanied by a certificate issued by an authorised tradesperson stating they have been properly degassed.

Refrigerator doors must be removed.

#### **Green Waste**

Green waste can be taken to the Pingelly Refuse Site on Rickard Street so it can be diverted from land fill. Please do not mix any other rubbish with your green waste.



#### Please do not...

Please do not put any of these items in the skip bin!

- Motor vehicle batteries (compaction causes fire);
- · Any part of a motor vehicle;
- Sand or lawn sods;
- Cement or asbestos products, including fibro fencing;
- Hazardous liquids. These include oil, paint, chemicals, pesticides etc;
- Air conditioners or refrigerators. (Unless doors off, certified and degassed);
- Oil filled radiators/room heaters:
- Glass that is broken, unless wrapped and bagged;
- Bricks and building rubble, for example cement, plaster, tiles etc can be taken to the Shire of Pingelly Refuse Site free of charge for residents:
- Metal of any type Unless cut to a maximum of 1.8m in length, width and height, and not solid. Metal can be disposed of at the Shire of Pingelly Refuse Site free of charge;
- Tyres The Pingelly Refuse site will accept tyres at a set fee as per the fees and charges; and

 Food and household waste can be placed in our normal 240 litre green top rubbish bin for weekly kerbside pickup.

#### **Please Remember:**

All waste is to be placed in the skip bin and to be kept below the top of the bin as marked.
