COMMUNITY GRANT SCHEME APPLICATIONS OPEN

The Shire's Community Grant Scheme has undergone changes to improve accessibility to the funding, re-align the priority areas to better reflect community aspirations from the 2020-30 Strategic Community Plan, as well as to simplify the application process.

Applications for Round 1 are now open and close on 25 June 2020 with the notification of outcome received by 17 July 2020. Despite the current ambiguity around the timing of non-essential social gatherings being reinstated, community groups are encouraged to still apply, as projects have up to 12 months to be delivered from the time of receiving the funding.
