## ALBANY HIGHWAY PROJECTS 2020-21

Main Roads will be undertaking a significant amount of road works on the Albany Highway between September 2020 and April 2021 to improve road safety and freight efficiency.

Seal widening on Albany Highway between Bedfordale Road Train Assembly Area and Williams (121km) is due to commence in early September 2020 and be completed by the end of December 2020.

Construction of a northbound overtaking lane, 20 kms north of Williams on the Albany Hwy is due to commence in September 2020 and be completed by the end of December 2020.

Intersection improvements on the Albany Highway at Crossman Road and Crossman Dwarda Road are due to commence in January 2021 and be completed by April 2021. The south bound rest area in between the intersections will also be upgraded.

For the safety of road users and road workers, there will be lane closures and speed restrictions. Road users are urged to slow down when approaching worksites, obey all signs and signals and show courtesy to other road users.

## HAVE YOUR SAY: DRAFT TOURISM STRATEGY

The Shire of Pingelly, in partnership with the Pingelly Tourism Group, has drafted a Tourism Strategy based on the ideas and discussions captured from the community workshop held in June.

A whole of tourism sector approach was explored by considering five key focus areas that align the emerging opportunities within the capacity of our community. These focus areas include: Product and Experience Development, Partnerships, Infrastructure, Marketing and Promotion and Events.

The draft version of the Tourism Strategy is now available to view in-person at the Shire Office, or online from the Shire's website.

The opportunity to submit any further feedback or comments will be open until 22 September, enabling the Pingelly Tourism Group and Council to consider any proposed changes by October 2020.
