MOUNTAIN BIKE & CYCLING STRATEGY

The Shire of Pingelly is currently holding a survey to gather feedback from the community regarding the proposal of a Mountain Bike and Cycling Strategy.

Pingelly is well placed to become a cycling centre due to its easy layout, wide streets, compact main street and the size of the town which means that any location is within 2-3km – an easy cycling distance. The advent of the e-bike (and e-scooters) has now made cycling accessible for most and not just the pastime of more active people.

Building a culture where local people cycle short distances instead of using their private vehicles requires a combination of actions including cycle recreational and transport infrastructure and behaviour change programs.
