

If you are a house or land owner within the Shire of Pingelly, please expect to see your rates either in the post or email depending on your preference of delivery.

Minimum Rates increased from \$950 to \$993. Residential Rubbish Collection (General Waste weekly & Recycling fortnightly) increased 4.5% to \$335 per year. The Average rate rise is 4.5% instead of 6% as the additional 2% for Wheatbelt Secondary Freight Network will not be levied this year.

Rates in full or first instalment are due 27 September 2022. As an added incentive to pay your rates on time, local businesses have sponsored three different prizes. To enter the draw simply pay your rates in full by the first instalment date.
