
WORK ON ALL AGES FOOTPATH

This stage will join the existing footpath on Somerset Street to Paragon Street via Review Street. This will enable a 4km loop walk/bike ride, along Paragon Street to the school and then using the All Ages Path Stage 1 back to Somerset Street.

This stage will also include construction of the path on Raglan Street, between Review and Brown Streets.

This work will complement our existing footpath network, and provide new connection the north east corner of the town. The Shire has obtained grant funding for this project in its work, with the Department of Transport (State Government) and Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program (Federal Government) each funding 50% of the cost.
