# Shire News

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## Works Update

- Contractors are laying the synthetic green on the new bowling green.
- The Parks & Gardens Team, along with Work For the Dole participants, are carrying out garden maintenance.
- Review Street road construction and drainage are progressing well with drainage pipes and side entry pits completed this week. Gravel carting and open drain stone pitching will be completed next week. Cement stabilisation is booked for Monday the 18th of February. The bitumen two coat seal is scheduled for Thursday the 21st of February. Motorists are advised traffic management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set. Due to one way traffic flows on Review Street during construction times some road closures will be in place for traffic entering Review Street from Realm, Stratford, James, Raglan, and Shannon Street during construction times.
- A grave has been prepared for a funeral on Tuesday the 12th of February.
- The Shire will be undertaking a culvert replacement on Aviation Street as part of the RAV network application for compliance on Aviation Street.
- The Shire of Pingelly has been successful in our lobbying for WANDRRA funding for storm damage in January 2018 for North Wandering Road, Wickepin Pingelly Road and several minor roads. This has delayed work to undertake repair sooner as any work undertaken prior to approval would have to be 100% from Shire Rates income instead only 25% of the cost. The Shire will now schedule this work as part of our works program.
- The annual property inspections for 2019/20 budget program were carried out during the week.



## Restricted Burning Period

- Permits to burn are required during this period.

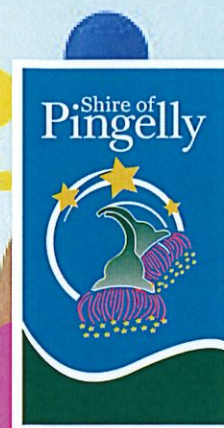
