


Swimming Pool Closure

Works Update

 Maintenance grading has been carried out on South Kweda, Dwarlaking and Jingaring Roads.



- The Parks and Gardens Team have planted out some garden beds at the PRACC and will be mulching the northern gardens next week.
- Backfilling of kerbing has been completed this week. Some additional signage has been
 ordered as part of Main Roads review of the line marking plan. Line marking will be
 scheduled by Main Roads when contractors are available. Motorists are advised traffic
 management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set.
- Road reconstruction work on a section of York Williams Road between North Wandering Road
 and Ulbrich Road with gravel being carted to widen the road to a ten metre formation. Wet
 mixing and a bitumen two coat seal will be completed before Easter. Motorists are advised
 traffic management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set.
- WANDRRA funded drainage repairs have been carried out on the open drain on Stratford Street from storm damage in 2017.
- Traffic hazard signage has been erected on Aldersyde Road east of Powell Road to warn motorists of a road failure. Repairs will be carried out when a crew is available.
- Maintenance work continuing on CEO residence, proposed date for internal painting is 2 April 2019.
- Minor building maintenance issues completed on Shire Buildings.
- Sime Building has been undertaking defects repairs at the PRACC this week.
- Selected street signs have been erected with the remaining back log of signs to be installed in April 2019.




