Public Comment on Potential Waste Legislation Reforms

The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation is seeking public comments on potential waste legislation reforms. They have released an issues paper "Waste Not, Want Not: Valuing Waste as a Resource", which outlines possible reforms to support use of waste-derived materials and Western Australia's move to a circular economy. Comments provided in response to this paper, which can be found on the Department's "Open Consultations" webpage, will inform the legislative direction for waste-derived materials. 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Works Update



- Gravel shoulder maintenance work has been completed on Wickepin-Pingelly Road between Bullaring Road and Old Wickepin Road (western access).
- The timber bridge structure at Bridge No 3097 on Bullaring Road has been removed. Contractors have poured the concrete base, wing and headwalls. The box culverts have been lifted onto the slab. Earthworks to reinstate the road will commence this week. The project was scheduled for completion by late-June however due to delays the project will be completed in July. Motorists are advised the gravel side track is open and to follow signage and speed limits set. A lighting tower is being used to illuminate the site at night. This work is fully funded by Main Roads WA for Shires that have a compliant bridge maintenance program.
- Traffic hazard signage is in place on Aldersyde Road east of Powell Road to warn motorists of a road failure.
- Winter maintenance grading work will recommence this week
- Storm damage repair work on Jingaring Road has been completed. Five roads on the western side of Pingelly still need drainage repair work done to finalise the WANDRRA claim.
- Private works of local transport business for hardstand area development has been completed.
- Aviation Street has been approved by Main Roads Heavy Haulage Branch for inclusion in the RAV 4 Network
- Traffic counter to be place on a series of gravel road for data collection for heavy vehicle movement for inclusion in road permit for Main Roads WA.
- Traffic counters will be installed on Brains, Fairhead & Hastings Roads this week.
- Work will be carried out to reinstate the inside of the community gym building in preparation for handing back to the Pingelly Community Resource Centre.

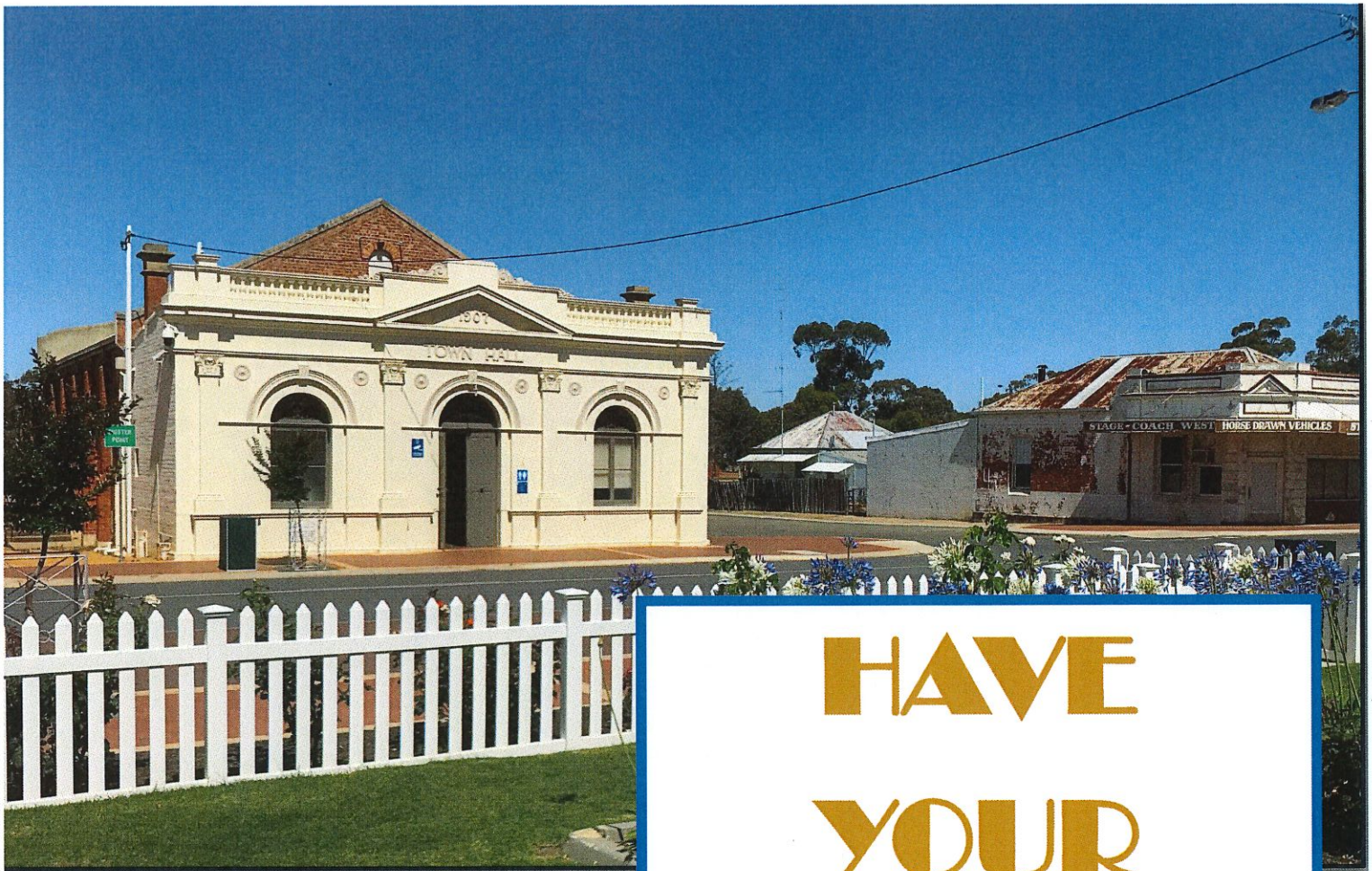

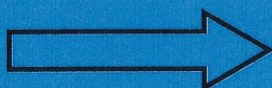
