of September and should be completed by mid-September. Motorists are advised traffic


management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS 19 OCTOBER 2019 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Nominations are called for the Local Government Election to be held on Saturday 19 October 2019 to fill vacancies on the Shire of Pingelly Council.

Nomination Time and Place

- Nominations for all vacancies open on Thursday 5 September 2019
- Nominations must be lodged by 4pm on Thursday 12 September 2019

Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer at any time during the above period to the Shire of Pingelly.

Nomination Requirements

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

- A completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. This form is available from the Shire of Pingelly Administration Office, along with a nomination package.
- A single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of biographical information about the proposed candidate and statements of the candidate's policies or beliefs
- A nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, postal order, bank cheque or Electronic Funds Transfer)
- A recent passport sized photograph (optional)

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted, faxed or emailed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations. If faxing or emailing a nomination, please contact the returning officer to ensure the nomination has been received, before the close of nominations.

Full details about eligibility and nomination procedures for prospective candidates in the election can be obtained by contacting the Shire of Pingelly.

New provisions are now in force which require any person wishing to stand for Council to have undertaken a mandatory induction. Unless the training has been satisfactorily completed, the Returning Officer (appointed by the WA Electoral Commissioner) is required to reject the nominations. Details are on the Department of Local Government, Sporting and Cultural Industries website. At the end of the induction, there is a registration form to be completed, printed and given to the Returning Officer when submitting a candidate nomination. 
