A Special Council Meeting will be held at 9am on Wednesday 9 October 2019 to consider the date for the Extraordinary Election.



Funding Success for Alternative Water Supply Project

The Shire of Pingelly has been successful in receiving a grant of \$63,094 to construct a stone pitched flume to channel stormwater to the Rennet Street Dam. This project is a key part of a longer term program to increase alternative water supplies to the town. The flume will decrease future silting of the stormwater catchment dam and increase water harvesting for use on community sporting fields. The project is planned to be completed by June 2020.

Where does your recycling go?

Following collection, recycling is transported back to the Great Southern Waste Disposal Facility in Narrogin. Recyclable material is then sorted into individual categories and baled ready for transportation. These bales are transported to various Recycling Facilities in Perth for markets locally and overseas.

Dog and Cat Registration Renewals

The Shire of Pingelly Dog and Cat registration renewals are due to be paid by 31 October 2019. If you have not received your renewal form by the end of the week please contact the Shire to check that your contact details are current. If you receive a renewal notice for an animal you no longer have, please let us know so the Shire records can be updated.



2019/20 Fire Season

The Restricted Burning Period commenced on 19 September and will run until 31 October inclusive. Permits must be obtained during this period.



To ensure that your property is compliant, all fire hazard reduction must be complete by 31 October 2019. If your property is non-compliant at the end of this period, infringements will be issued.

Works Update

- Storm damage repair work is scheduled to be completed on Napping Pool and Walwalling Roads by Friday the 4th of October to finalise the WANDRRA claim.
- Gravel sheeting will commence next week on Zig Zag Road as part of the Commodity Route funding program. Traffic management will be on site and motorists are advised to follow signage and speed limits set.
- WA Treeworks have been pruning trees on road reserves which Western Power have listed as too close to power lines.
- Parks & Gardens have been slashing verges and reserves in town. The oval has been verti mowed and fertilised.
- Repair work and cleaning has commenced on the CWA building. These are required prior to handing the building back to the CRC.
