PART 111 PREVENTION OF BUSH FIRES

SECTION 17 - EXTENSION OF PROHIBITED BURNING PERIOD

Pursuant to Section 17 Bush Fires Act 1954 the Shire of Pingelly advises it has extended its Prohibited Burning Period for an additional fourteen (14) calendar days, due to the very dry seasonal conditions.

Prohibited Burning will conclude midnight Friday 28 February 2020.

#### This means:

- · NO fires are to be lit during this period.
- · NO fire permits will be issued by Fire Control Officers.

This decision will be reviewed at that date having regard for the seasonal conditions applicable at the time.
