#### **DISABILITY AWARENESS FOCUS CONTINUES**





Recently the Shire of Pingelly team in partnership with Forrest Personnel led Diversity, Access and Inclusion training for Local Governments in the southern Wheatbelt. The event attracted the attendance of local government staff from Brookton to Kojonup.

A second workshop facilitated by Forrest Personnel empowered representatives from local businesses and community groups with strategies to assist local people living with a disability to enter paid and voluntary roles. With 20% of the Pingelly population living with a health condition or disability, increasing workforce participation will improve the quality of life for someone you know in the community.

The Shire of Pingelly and Forrest Personnel would like to thank the Pingelly Community Resource Centre for catering the evening and providing the venue for this important conversation. These workshops were funded by the Lighthouse Project, delivered by LG Professionals WA. #### RESTRICTED BURNING

#### WORKS UPDATE

- Maintenance grading has commenced on the western end of Shaddick Rd
- Parks and Gardens staff have been concentrating on fertilising parks and gardens after the recent rainfall
- Bulk earthworks have been completed on Bodey Stintersection.
- Yenellin Rd shoulders have been boxed out and gravelled ready for the surveyor to set final levels
- Traffic management signage has been placed on a road pavement failure on Dwarlarking Rd, with emergency repairs to be carried out next week to make it trafficable before the next rain event
