

MAKE RECYCLING PART OF YOUR DAY IN PINGELLY

These items can go into your yellow bin:

Aluminium and steel cans (rinsed)

Glass bottles and jars (unbroken and rinsed with lids removed)

Milk and juice cartons (rinsed)

All plastic containers (rinsed with lids separate. Check the recycling number on the container.)

Paper, newspapers and magazines

Cardboard boxes should be folded flat



N.B. Check the recycling number on the package or bottle eg 1-6 0r

These items should not go into your yellow bin:

Plastic bags or film/cling wrap, bubble packaging.

Disposable nappies

Syringes, needles, broken glass or any sharps

Window glass and ceramics (crockery) or pottery

Aerosol cans

Food, garden waste

Light bulbs, batteries, pizza boxes or general rubbish

Polystyrene or Foam packaging

For items that may go into your yellow-top bin, check the sticker on the lid.

If you don't have a sticker on the lid or you require any other information regarding recycling, please contact the Shire Administration Office on 9887 1066.

At the Waste Facility/Landfill location on Rickart Road

Gas bottles, car batteries and waste oil

White goods, light metal, fencing wire, car bodies & batteries.

Green waste and general waste

Tyres, wood and pallets

N.B. Metals should be separated into light metal, white goods, fencing wire and car bodies.

The new Drop-Off Facility has been built, but we are not ready to start taking items for recycling yet.
