

MANAGER FINANCE

An exciting opportunity exists for a Manager Finance at the Shire of Pingelly.

This is a key position reporting to the Chief Executive Officer. This executive position is responsible for the responsible financial management and responsible governance of the Shire of Pingelly, including payroll, rates, the annual budget, the long-term financial plan, IT and delivery of high-quality customer service to the community.

The successful candidate will have accounting qualifications, or at least five years' demonstrated experience in a financial management position within Local Government. A high level of written and verbal communication skills, Local Government Act and Regulations will be highly regarded. Leadership, motivation, attitude and alignment with the Shire's values are essential for success in this role.

A total salary package up to \$137,600pa for a three or five year contract will be negotiated, dependent on qualifications, skills and experience. This includes a cash salary of up to \$100,000pa, up to 17% superannuation, five weeks' annual leave, together with private use of an executive vehicle and subsidised housing.
