MEMORIAL PARK REDEVELOPMENT



The Memorial Park Redevelopment has been running smoothly with minimal disruptions.

The past fortnight has seen the installation of the play fort to form part of the junior play space, as well as the installation of swings, water play feature, swings and granite boulders. The Water Corporation Meter has also been upgraded.



During the next fortnight, the second stage of concrete works will commence which will form the footpath network throughout the precinct. The flying fox will also be installed, along with the turf soil and furniture items. Various utility functions will be undertaken including plumbing, drainage and electrical works.

Adverse Events Plan

Council endorsed the Adverse Events Plan which has been designed to identify a range of risks and the degree of impact that they would have on the community. This Plan is a requirement of the Federal funding for the Memorial Park re-development project.

Creation of Tutanning Nature Reserve Financial Reserve Account

Council approved the creation of a new financial reserve account for the Tutanning Reserve. The purpose of the reserve is for the operations, improvements and promotion of Tutanning Reserve. Council also considered a Memorandum of Understanding between the Shire of Pingelly, Pingelly Tourism Group and Department of Biodiversity Conservation and Attractions to allow the Percy Marshall Research Centre to be used as tourism accommodation.

Appointment of Acting Chief Executive Officer

Council appointed Mr Paul Sheedy to the role of Acting Chief Executive Officer, commencing on 18 June 2021 until a new permanent CEO commences.

Pingelly Tourism Group – Proposed Lease

Council approved a lease of the Old Pony Club Grounds to the Pingelly Tourism Group.

Bushfire Advisory Committee Minutes

Council endorsed the appointment of Mr Rod Shaddick as Chief Bush Fire Control Officer and Sam MacNamara and Brodie Cunningham as dual Deputy Chief Bush Fire Control Officers.
