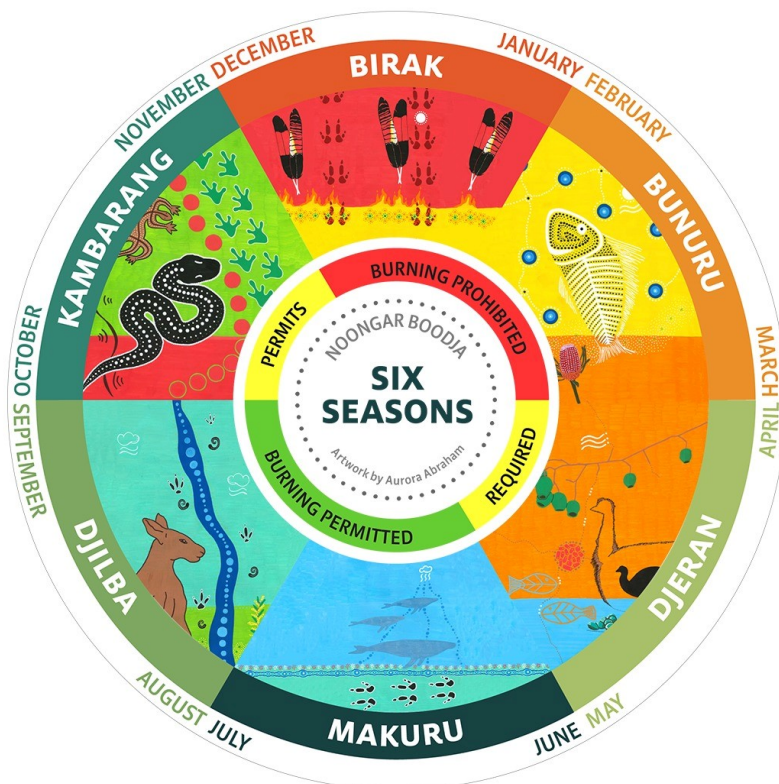


TOWN HALL TOILETS NOW OPEN
