## PERTH NAIDOC MALE ELDER OF THE YEAR

The Shire of Pingelly would like to congratulate local indigenous Elder and recipient of the Perth NAIDOC award for Male Elder of 2022, Mr Desmond Little.

Mr Little has a previous history of working tirelessly within our community, developing opportunities for Aboriginal Youth and Families with training and employment through his shearing team and the farming sector.

Desmond came from humble beginnings, originally from Pumphreys Bridge, Mr Little has broken down racial barriers in the sporting and education areas allowing Aboriginal people an opportunity to reach their potential, further their education and fulfil their dreams.

Mr Little also coached the Pingelly Tigers Football Club back in the 1960's, when indigenous players from Pingelly and surrounding towns banded together to create a team to compete in the local league. The creation of the Pingelly Tigers has since woven through the AFL with many local aboriginal football players making it to regional and state squads and teams.

This is a true credit to Mr Little who now resides in Perth and operates as the Chair of his local Noongar Centre.

Congratulations Desmond on all your hard work and dedication to the people of Pingelly and Western Australia.
