SWIMMING POOL OPENING 5 NOV

PROHIBITED BURNING PERIOD

During this period you are required to maintain the hazard reduction on your properties. The lighting of fires is strictly forbidden.

Use of Mowers & Whipper Snipper/Slashers

- Prohibited during Harvest Bans, Vehicle Movement Bans or Total Fire Bans.
- Prohibited between 6.00 am to 6.00 pm during the prohibited burning period unless on a reticulated area. (This means the grass is "green" and non-combustible).
- Vegetation that is not green and flammable and that can be reticulated, can be slashed between 6.00am and 6.00pm but must be well watered prior to mowing, whipper snipping or slashing (that is within the hour of watering) so that there is no chance of "sparking" and must remain damp during the operation.
- The area in an orchard that is not watered between rows if the trees are reticulated by drippers is not considered to be reticulated.
- As an added precaution have a "watcher" on hand with a hose.
- The use of disk or slashing type machines for agricultural purposes during the Prohibited Burning Period is to be by specific permit from the Chief Bushfire Control Officer or the Deputy CBFEO.
