## WICKEPIN-PINGELLY ROAD UPGRADES

The Wickepin-Pingelly Road upgrade works are well underway. The road formation has been widened to 10 meters in parts, culverts have been replaced and upgraded. 100mm of stabilised gravel will be applied to sections of the road in preparation for a bitumen seal. It is anticipated that the bitumen will be laid in late April.
