Works Update

 Contractors have finalised the levelling of the cracker dust on the new bowling green. The synthetic green has been delivered to site and will be installed by the contractors.



- The Parks & Gardens team, along with Work for the Dole participants, are carrying out garden maintenance.
- Street Road construction and drainage works have commenced with the drainage pipe and side entry pits completed this week. Gravel carting started on Friday and will continue next week. Motorists are advised traffic management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set. Due to one way traffic flows on Review Street during construction times some road closures will be in place for traffic entering Review Street from Realm, Stratford, James, Raglan, and Shannon Street during construction times.
- Maintenance grading this week has been carried out on Tutanning Road.
- In January 2019 we received 10 requests and have five outstanding.



Prohibited Burning

- Current date until 14 February (inclusive) Note:
- Permits may only be issued on a daily basis.
- Permits are only issued for the purpose of protective burning (around houses, sheds etc.) Permits are valid between the hours of 4pm and mid-night. Hours of burning may be shortened as a condition of the permits, e.g. usual practice for town is burning between 6pm and 11pm only.
- Permits will only be issued up to 11pm on 14 December during this period.
- At least three people must be in attendance for the duration of the burn.
- A reminder that a Fire Control Officer receiving a request for a permit during the Prohibited Burning Period is not obligated to issue the permit if they consider the conditions too hazardous for burning.

Shredded Paper

The Shire currently has surplus bags of shredded paper available for collection from the administration building. This is offered on a first in first served basis. Please attend the Shire Office to make collection.


