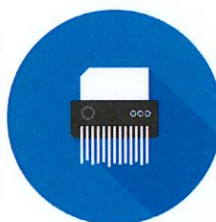
## Volunteers Needed

## Prescribed Burns

Sometimes when you smell and see smoke it could mean that a prescribed burn is taking place. Prescribed burning reduces the amount of ground vegetation during cooler months to decrease risk of bushfires that could cause greater damage later in the season. Prescribed burning also helps to maintain biodiversity and assists with vegetation management.



Many of Western Australia's (WA) prescribed burns are managed by the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) Parks and Wildlife service and generally take place from March through to November each year in both urban and rural regional areas.

## Works Update

- The Parks and Gardens Team have mulched the northern garden beds at the PRACC.
  - Road reconstruction work on a section of York Williams Road between North Wandering Road and Ulbrich Road is almost completed with final clean-up works happening this week and early next week. Wet-mixing is scheduled for the 11<sup>th</sup> of April. The date for the bitumen two coat seal will be confirmed next week however it is expected to be completed before Easter. Motorists are advised traffic management will be on site and to follow signage and speed limits set.

- Maintenance grading has been carried out on Dwarlaking, Cousins and Hickmott Roads.
  - Traffic hazard signage has been erected on Aldersyde Road east of Powell Road to warn motorists of a road failure. Repairs will be carried out when a crew is available.
  - Painting of the CEO's residence is complete. Carpets will be cleaned on Wednesday 10 April 2019 and house given a clean inside and out in preparation for viewings on Friday 12 April 2019.
  - Minor building maintenance issues sorted on Shire Building.
  - Shire staff are finalising details for items that Council have approved to sale or disposal for advertising before Easter.
  - A plot in the Memorial Rose Garden at the Cemetery was prepared for the interment of ashes.

In March 2019 the Shire received 26 works requests, of which 15 were actioned. The **total** of works requests outstanding to date for 2019 is 25.
