Public Comment on Potential Waste Legislation Reforms

The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation is seeking public comments on potential waste legislation reforms. They have released an issues paper "Waste Not, Want Not: Valuing Waste as a Resource", which outlines possible reforms to support use of waste-derived materials and Western Australia's move to a circular economy. Comments provided in response to this paper, which can be found on the Department's "Open Consultations" webpage, will inform the legislative direction for waste-derived materials. 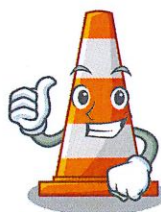

Works Update



- The Parks and Gardens Team have continued with their maintenance programs.
- Traffic hazard signage is in place on Aldersyde Road east of Powell Road to warn motorists of a road failure. Repairs will be carried out when a crew is available.
- Minor building maintenance issues completed including cleaning of shire building gutters.
- Winter maintenance grading work has been carried out on Merwanga and Milton Roads.
- A grave has been prepared for a funeral on Monday 17th of June. A plot will also be prepared for the interment of ashes into the Memorial Rose Garden also from Monday 17th of June 2019.
- The Bowling Green has been marked for installation of shade structures by a contractor and bowling club volunteers.
- Storm damage repair work on Jingaring is programmed to be completed next week. This will leave five roads in the western side of Pingelly that still need drainage work completed. This is WANDRRA funded work.
- The old display fridge from the Town Hall has been sold along with the old piano from demolished Recreation Building by online auction. The remaining unsold items from the old medical centre are currently available for purchase (please see Shire Website for details).
- The timber bridge structure at Bridge No 3097 on Bullaring Road has been removed. Contractors have poured the concrete slab and 27 box culverts have been lifted onto the slab. Work has now started on forming up the head and wing walls. The project is scheduled for completion by late June. Motorists are advised the gravel side track is open and to follow signage and speed limits set. A lighting tower is being used to illuminate the site at night. This work is fully funded by Main Roads WA for Shire that have a compliant bridge maintenance program.

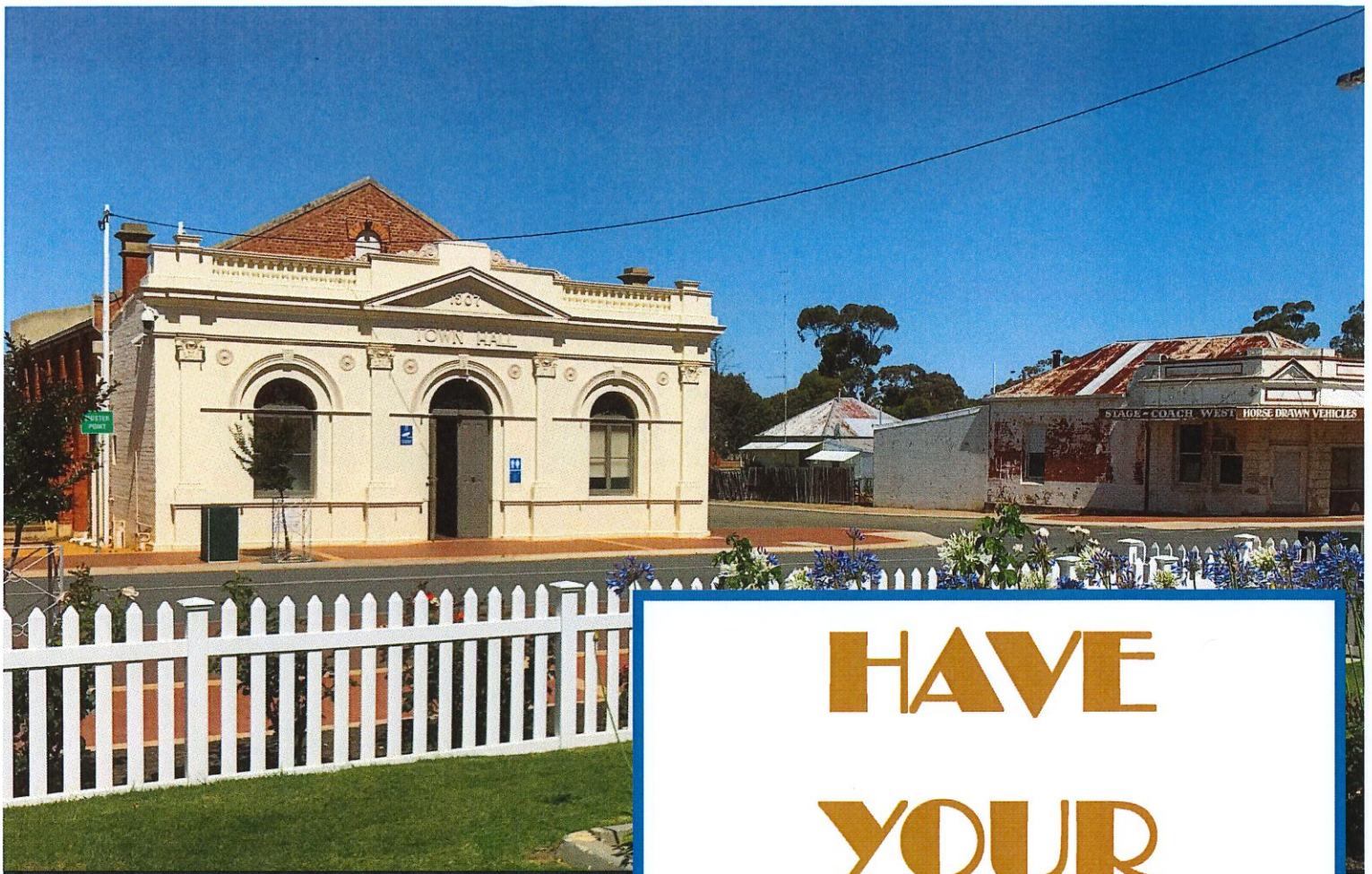

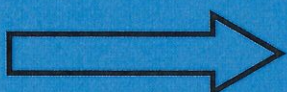
HAVE YOUR SAY !!
