Important Dates:

- Close of electoral rolls is 5pm on Thursday 28 November 2019—this means if you would like to nominate to become a Councillor, or if you would like to vote at the election your name MUST be on the electoral roll by this date. You can check your enrolment by visiting:

- Nominations for Council open at 8.30am Wednesday 4 December and close at 4pm on Wednesday 11 December 2019.
- If more than one nomination is received, voting will commence on Thursday 12 December 2019 and run until 4pm Thursday 16 January 2020 (the day before election day) at the Shire Office.
- Election Day—Friday 17 January 2020—voting from 8am to 6pm at the Shire Office.

Both absent and postal voting will be available if you will be away during the voting period or cannot attend the Shire office to lodge your vote.

2019/20 Fire Season

The Restricted Burning Period commenced on 19 September and will run until 31 October inclusive. Permits must be obtained during this period.



To ensure that your property is compliant, all fire hazard reduction must be complete by 31 October 2019. If your property is non-compliant at the end of this period, infringements will be issued.

Please refer to the Fire Control Order that was issued with the Rates Notices or contact the Shire Office for further information.

Works Update

- Maintenance grading has been undertaken on Madill Road.
- The tree clearing has been completed, and the removal of overburden has started on Zig Zag Road as part of the Commodity Route funding program. The road is to be closed to all but local traffic only. Traffic management will be on site and motorists are advised to follow signage and speed limits set.
- Parks & Gardens have been slashing verges and reserves in town.
- The entrance to Stratherne and Wickepin Roads has had cement stabilised gravel put down to prevent scuffing by trucks.
- Gutters on various Shire buildings have been cleaned out.
- Safety barrier and signs were erected for the "Teddy Bears Picnic" day in Memorial Park.
- Mosquito control has been completed around the town dam and other Shire controlled water sources.
