- Election Day—Friday 17 January 2020—voting from 8am to 6pm at the Shire Office.

Both absent and postal voting will be available if you will be away during the voting period or cannot attend the Shire office to lodge your vote.

Works Update

• Maintenance grading works have been carried out on Tutanning, Milton and Woyerling Roads.



- Various driveways around town have had cement stabilised gravel put in to repair erosion/ scour
- The clearing of trees and overburden has been completed on Zig Zag Road with some drainage upgrades remaining. The crew are shifting their focus to the carting and spreading of gravel. The road will be closed to all but local traffic only. Traffic management will be on site and motorists are advised to follow signage and speed limits set.
- WA Treeworks have been pruning trees on road reserves which Western Power have listed as too close to power lines and has been completed.
- Parks & Gardens have been slashing verges and reserves in town and have been paying
 particular attention to the removal of Gazania plants that are encroaching on to road
 edges, causing them to weaken the bitumen seal.
- Various fallen trees have been removed from the rural road network.
- Patching of potholes ongoing throughout the sealed road network.
- Minor building maintenance issues completed.
